About CUET

The Common University Entrance Test (CUET (UG) is conducted for admission into all UG Programmes in all Central Universities for academic session 2023-24 under the Ministry of Education, (MoE). The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) will provide a common platform and equal opportunities to candidates across the country, especially those from rural and other remote areas and help establish better connect with the Universities. A single examination will enable the Candidates to cover a wide outreach and be part of the admissions process to various Central Universities.



Eligibility Criteria for CUET (UG) 2024


The eligibility criteria for candidates who will appear for the upcoming CUET (UG) 2024 is given below:

- Candidates who have passed the **class 12th or equivalent examination or are appearing in 2024** irrespective of their age can appear in the CUET (UG) 2024. However, candidates have to fulfil the age criteria if it is specified by a particular University to which the candidate wishes to apply.
- There is **no age limit** for candidates who want to apply for CUET (UG) 2024.

The **CUET** exam is divided into three sections, namely:

Scheme of CUET (UG) 2024 **Examination:**

CUET (UG) 2024 will be a Computer Based Test (CBT). It will comprise Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). The total marks allotted for each section is 200 and every question will carry **5 marks**. There is **negative** marking and 1 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer.

 - **GK** (Polity, History, Geography, Economics & Current Affairs)

Subject Selection

1. . A Candidate can take a maximum of 10 Subjects in the following manner.

- Candidate can opt maximum 10 Subjects 2 Languages, 7 Domain Subjects & General Test. According to the requirements of his/her intended University and Course.
- Any 1 Language, Minimum 3 Domain Subjects & General Test. According to this candidate is eligible for all the courses under University of Delhi.
- 2. Candidates should select those Domain Subjects that they have already studied in class 12. In case a particular subject is not there in the CUET Domain Subject list, then candidates can choose a subject that is most similar to what they have studied in class 12.
